Multimedia Coordinator

Reporting to the Brand and Digital Manager, the Multimedia Coordinator will coordinate and assist with the implementation of the content strategy for the Manly Warringah Sea Eagles. This role will primarily focus on digital content creation (video and photography) and graphic design (Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign), but will also provide assistance to the traditional media and PR function by supporting general media activities such as press conferences and associated events.

Working in a highly focused team environment, this diverse role will suit a driven, proactive and passionate self-starter with a demonstrated ability to work in a fast paced environment whilst maintaining attention to detail. The ability to work independently as well as collaboratively within the wider team structure is key; you must be prepared to roll up your sleeves and work hands-on as required.

The ideal candidate will be experienced in both pre- and post-production of digital content, including filming, editing, graphic design and creation of imagery and other digital assets, with the ability to identify and document content on the fly. An understanding of rugby league is required, as is flexibility and willingness to work where and when the stories are happening, including both home and away games across all grades.

With a focus on creating compelling content and storytelling across multiple platforms and mediums, this is an exciting opportunity to play an integral role in the engagement of existing fans, as well as capturing and growing new audiences. Key Responsibilities

Media

- Work with Manly Media to develop and generate well-crafted video and photography content for website and other social media platforms
- Creating digital assets and imagery for websites, social media, EDM and other advertising media
- Assist with game day content creation
- Assist with copywriting requirements

Website and Digital Content

- Assist with the Club website and social media channels (YouTube, Instagram and TikTok)
- Generate digital graphics, advertising, statistics and infographics for social media channels
- Assist with production and uploading of content onto club website and other platforms as required
- Edit and produce game highlight packages for all grades (Junior reps to NRL)

Social Media

- Work to support the execution of the digital and content plan, including publishing on the Club's social media accounts, promoting website content and pushing out important messages via relevant channels
- Daily administration support of social media platforms including posting, live tweeting and responding to questions on social media channels
- Create content, story concepts and images for social media channels
- Capture training and game day content
- Maintain an ongoing awareness of developments in digital marketing including trends, technology and emerging platforms.

Administration

- Updating content calendars and coordinating social and web reports
- Provide creative design support as necessary

Work, Health and Safety

- Take reasonable care for the health and safety of yourself and all employees' while at work

Location and Travel

This position is located in new offices in the Manly Sea Eagles Centre of Excellence at the North end of 4 Pines Park, 25 Federal Parade, Brookvale. On-site car parking is available. Travel to attend match days and other events will be required.

Hours of Work

This is a full time position with a normal week of 38 hours. Given the unique nature of the sports industry, working outside of office hours will be required including attending all match days (home and away games across all grades) throughout the season and other job related activities from time to time. A degree of flexibility is required.
